III. PERMIT TO MINE & RECLAMATION PLAN: TURNER EXCAVATING, INC. (California-Engels Mining Company, Owner); APN 007-080-004; T.27N/R.11E/S.8 MDM

The proposal to mine up to 100,000 cubic yards of construction aggregate from an existing previously disturbed overburden pile, including a seasonal rock crushing/screening plant, located approximately 11 miles northeast of Greenville, is presented. This is a continued public hearing from June 13, 2012. Randy Wilson, Zoning Administrator, states Staff has prepared a Staff Report; however, changes are necessary on the reclamation plan before action can be taken. Rebecca Herrin, Senior Planner, states they still need a response from Travis Deem, the applicant's consultant. Lynne Turner, applicant, states Travis is done and will provide it this week. Herrin replies that the County will prepare a response to the Department of Conservation, who then want 30 days to review our response. Wilson continues this item to July 11, 2012, at 10:00, with the public hearing open, noting that there may be another continuance.
