

RESOLUTION 12- 7814

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING DEPUTY CLERKS OF THE BOARD
TO SERVE IN THE ABSENCE OF THE CLERK OF THE BOARD**

WHEREAS, Plumas County Code §2-1.102 provides that the Board of Supervisors may appoint one or more deputy Clerks to the Board to serve in the absence of the Clerk of the Board, and;

WHEREAS, on May 06, 1997, the Clerk of the Board was appointed to serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Plumas County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. Lindsay Driscoll shall serve as the primary deputy Clerk of the Board, and Craig Settlemire, County Counsel shall serve as a deputy Clerk of the Board when neither the Clerk nor deputies are able to attend a special or emergency meeting of the Board of Supervisors.
2. Any work performed by a deputy clerk shall be subject to review and approval by the Clerk of the Board, and shall remain in the control and possession of the Clerk of the Board as permanent records of the Clerk of the Board.
3. This resolution shall be effective on the date of adoption and shall supersede any resolution appointing deputy Clerks of the Board.
