

RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATIONS FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR THE PROPOSITION 84 PRESERVATION OF RANCHES AND AGRICULTURAL LANDS GRANT PROGRAM UNDER THE SAFE WATER, WATER QUALITY AND SUPPLY, FLOOD CONTROL, RIVER AND COASTAL PROTECTION BOND ACT OF 2006.

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided Funds for the program shown above; and

WHEREAS, the Sierra Nevada Conservancy (SNC) has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of a portion of these funds through a local assistance grants program, establishing necessary procedures; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the Sierra Nevada Conservancy require a resolution certifying the approval of applications by the Applicant's governing board before submission of said applications to the SNC; and

WHEREAS, the Applicants, if selected will enter into agreements with the SNC to carry out the projects; and

WHEREAS, the County has identified the Sierra Valley Agricultural Water Quality Enhancement and Wildlife Corridor Project submitted by the Sierra Valley Resource Conservation District, Preventing Yellow Starthistle Spread in the Sierra Nevada Project, submitted by the Plumas County Department of Agriculture, and Plumas-Sierra Counties Noxious Weed Control and Eradication Project, submitted by the Plumas County Department of Agriculture, as valuable toward meetings its mission and goals.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Plumas, State of California, that this Board:

1. Approves the submittal of applications for the Sierra Valley Agricultural Water Quality Enhancement and Wildlife Corridor Project, Preventing Yellow Starthistle Spread in the Sierra Nevada Project, and Plumas-Sierra Counties Noxious Weed Control and Eradication Project; and
2. Certifies that the Applicants understand the assurances and certification requirements in the applications; and
3. Certifies that the Applicants will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the resource(s) consistent with the long-term benefits described in support of the applications if SNC provides the requested funds; and


4. Certifies that the Applicants will comply with all legal requirements as determined during the application process; and
5. Appoints the Agricultural Commissioner of Plumas and Sierra Counties as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to: applications, agreements, payment requests, and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the Preventing Yellow Starthistle Spread in the Sierra Nevada Project, and Plumas-Sierra Counties Noxious Weed Control and Eradication Project. In performing these actions, the Agricultural Commissioner shall comply with the Plumas County Purchasing Policy as well as all other applicable policies of Plumas County.
