The Sheriff of Plumas County is the Correctional Administrator for Plumas County and is responsible for overseeing the Plumas County Correctional Facility.. The Sheriff is charged with managing the population of the Plumas county Correctional Facility in accordance with the State and Federal law along with the mandates of the Consent Decree as set forth in the "STIPULATION AND ORDER RE: AMENDED CONSENT DECREE" filed under the United States District Court Eastern District of California, case # 89-1659 LKK-JMF.

In conjunction with the Plumas County Community Corrections Partnership, the Sheriff has developed a plan to mitigate the impacts of the *2011 Realignment Legislation Addressing Public Safety Act* – (AB 109) and the resulting increase in the population of the Plumas County Correctional Facility. That plan includes a Pretrial Release Program with the primary goal of

making room at the correctional facility for serious and/or dangerous inmates, while at the same time, ensuring public safety.

The Sheriff's Pretrial Release Program employs an evidence-based risk assessment protocol designed to determine the suitability for release of pretrial detainees determined to be "Low Risk". The program also utilizes enhanced supervision and monitoring of released inmates to mitigate risks to public safety and ensure attendance at court proceedings. The Sheriff has requested standing authority from the court to release "Low Risk" detainees on their own recognizance prior to arraignment with imposition of predetermined terms and conditions of release in accordance with section 1318 of the California Penal Code.

THE COURT DOES HEREBY ORDER that the Sheriff of Plumas County or his designee has the standing authority, without further authorization from the Court, to release "Low Risk" detainees, on their own recognizance, from the Plumas County Correctional Facility prior to arraignment with predetermined terms and conditions of release as delineated in "ATTACHMENT A" and in accordance with section 1318 of the California Penal Code.
