Resolution Ratifying the Declaration of a Local Emergency due to severe electrical power outages and heavy snowfall in Plumas County.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority under Section 4-1.05 of the Plumas County Code, on January 22, 2010 the Office of Emergency Services Director declared a local emergency within Plumas County due to the significant impacts of the snowfall in Plumas County and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid provisions of the County Code, the Board of Supervisors must ratify or reject the declaration of the local emergency within seven days and;

WHEREAS, the Board has received the report and recommendation from the Director of Emergency Services and considered the significant impacts that the snowfall has caused on the county.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that, the Board hereby ratifies the declaration of a local emergency due to snowfall conditions in Plumas County.




