NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, County of Plumas, State of California strongly, supports Plumas County Public Health Agency work with the California Department of Health Services, Office of Family Planning as a means of preventing teen and unintended pregnancies. Plumas County, California; the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Public Health to sign documents as the Boards designee.
