

Resolution No. 10- 7630

A RESOLUTION TO INCREASE AN ADDITIONAL PENALTY ON FINES, PENALTIES AND FORFEITURES IMPOSED BY THE SUPERIOR COURT TO FUND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, upon the enactment of Senate Bill 1236, Chapter 60 on July 3, 2008, Section 76000.5 of the Government Code was amended to authorize a county board of supervisors to elect to levy an additional penalty in the amount of \$2 for every \$10, upon fines, penalties and forfeitures collected for criminal offenses, and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 76000.5, the Board of Supervisors hereby elect to levy an additional penalty assessment of \$2.00,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, County of Plumas as follows:


1. For purposes of supporting emergency medical services pursuant to Chapter 2.5 of Division 2.5 of the Health and Safety Code, in addition to penalties set forth in Section 76000, the Board of Supervisors elect to levy an additional penalty in the amount of two dollars (\$2) for every ten dollars (\$10) or part of ten dollars (\$10), upon every fine penalty or forfeiture imposed by the Courts for all criminal offenses.
2. The additional penalty will be collected by the Court and/or the Treasurer-Tax Collector's Office in the same manner as the amounts established by Section 1464 of the Penal Code.

The foregoing resolution was duly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Plumas, State of California, at a regular meeting of the Board held on the 18th day of May, 2010, by the following vote:


