

RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 7642

A RESOLUTION CONSOLIDATING AN ELECTION WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SIERRA PLUMAS JOINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 2, 2010, AND AUTHORIZING THE PLUMAS COUNTY CLERK TO CONDUCT THE ELECTION FOR A SCHOOL BOND MEASURE AND THE ELECTION OF TRUSTEES TO THE DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD.

WHEREAS, The Sierra-Plumas Joint Unified School District has requested the Board of Supervisors in Plumas County to authorize the Plumas County Clerk to conduct an election for a school bond measure, to elect trustees to the district and to consolidate the election with the General Election to be held on November 2, 2010. Pursuant to Resolutions 09-017 and 009-019 hereto attached and made a part of, the following measure will be submitted to the voters within the district:

“To improve educational opportunities, increase safety, improve energy efficiency in our schools and qualify for State matching grants, shall Sierra-Plumas Joint Unified School District issue \$5 million in bonds, providing for a citizens’ oversight committee, annual audits, interest rates within legal limits, and no money for administrators’ salaries or school operating expenses, in order to renovate existing school buildings, update utilities, science laboratories, windows, and furniture, with all money raised benefiting our local students?”

WHEREAS, the following trustee areas will be up for election within the District:

Trustee Area #2	Four Year Term
Trustee Area #4	Four Year Term
Trustee Area #5	Four Year Term

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, County of Plumas, State of California, as follows:

1. The election of the school bond measure and election of trustees as set forth in Resolutions No. 09-017 and 009-019, which are incorporated here by reference in their entirety, is hereby consolidated with the November 2, 2010 General Election.
2. The Plumas County Clerk will conduct said election within the Plumas County boundaries of the Sierra-Plumas Joint Unified School District, including preparation and publication of all legal notices, providing necessary supplies and equipment, preparation of official ballots, canvassing the returns and taking all

other necessary steps required under state and local law in conducting a consolidated election.


3. The Plumas County Clerk is authorized to recover expenses for any election service performed, by advance payment or reimbursement from the district.

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Plumas County Clerk, Registrar of Voters, is hereby authorized and directed to consolidate and conduct the election for trustees and the school bond measure in accordance with the applicable state and local laws governing the General Election to be held on November 2, 2010, on this 13th day of July, 2010, by the following vote:


