RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO GRANT PERMISSION AND PROVIDE SUPPORT FOR THE SOLICITATION OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS' (HUD) SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES REGIONAL PLANNING GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE GENERAL PLAN UPDATE AND DETAILED EXECUTION PLANS AND PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, the contract between the General Plan Update Consultant and the County outlines that there may be opportunities for the Consultant to solicit grant funds to augment the County's existing General Plan Update Budget and the consultant's efforts and time in developing the optional elements of economics, water, and forestry/ agriculture as well as providing additional support in the area of public engagement and the development of zoning ordinances and community plan documents that will support the Updated General Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors supported the exploration of available grant funds as long as all such opportunities to solicit funds are vetted and approved by the Board of Supervisors, and

WHEREAS, there was an expectation by the Board of Supervisors that additional funding opportunities would be researched and solicited to fill funding gaps in the areas identified above in order to produce policy documents that will provide the County with the guidance to direct development over the next 20 years that is a reflection of the needs of the communities and people of Plumas County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Plumas, State of California approve and actively support the solicitation of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Affairs' Sustainable Communities Regional Planning Grant Funds.


