

RESOLUTION NO. 2010- 7650

RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF PLUMAS AND THE BARGAINING UNITS OF GENERAL, MID-MANAGEMENT AND CRAFTS & TRADES REPRESENTED BY OPERATING ENGINEERS LOCAL #3

WHEREAS, the negotiation team for the Board of Supervisors and the negotiation team for the General, Crafts & Trades and Mid-Management Units represented by Operating Engineers Local #3 have met and conferred in good faith and have reached a tentative agreement for a Memorandum of Understanding covering wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment, for the General, Crafts & Trades and Mid-Management Unit employees. The period covered under this tentative agreement is July 1, 2010 through August 30, 2011.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors have reviewed and concurs with terms and conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding for the General Unit, Crafts & Trades Unit and the Mid-Management Unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Plumas County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. Board of Supervisors ratifies and accepts the Memorandum of Understandings for the General Unit, Crafts & Trades Unit and Mid-Management Unit as set forth in the copies of the Memorandum of Understanding attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A, B and C.
2. The County Administrative Officer, Auditor/Controller and Human Resources Director are hereby directed to implement the provisions of the memorandum of understanding and the Board Chair is authorized to execute the individual Memorandum of Understandings and any other documents related hereto in order to carry out this ratification.




