

Resolution No. 11- 7674

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE AUDITOR AS THE OFFICER TO EXERCISE
THE AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO GRANT DISCHARGE
OF ACCOUNTABILITY

WHEREAS, Government Code 25259.5, authorizes the Board of Supervisors to adopt a resolution designating the County Auditor as the officer to exercise the authority of the board under that section to grant discharge of accountability under certain circumstances; and,

WHEREAS, the Treasurer-Collections Administrator finds that the collection efforts on court-ordered debt (fines/fees) is less than the cost of collection or is determined to be uncollectible, Government Code 25258; and,

WHEREAS, discharging the responsibility for collection does not release the debtor from liability for the debt, Government Code 25257 & 25259.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, County of Plumas as follows:


The County Auditor be designated as the officer to exercise the authority of the Board under Government Code 25259.5, to order discharge of accountability upon the request of the Treasurer-Collection Administrator.
