RESOLUTION OF THE PLUMAS COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
ESTABLISHING FILING FEE FOR BOARD OF EQUALIZATION
ASSESSMENT APPEALS

WHEREAS, Article XIII, Section 18 of the California Constitution empowers the Board of Supervisors in each county to adopt rules of notice and procedures for assessment appeals boards as may be required to facilitate their work and to insure uniformity in the processing and decision of equalization petitions; and

WHEREAS, the County of Plumas presently does not charge applicants a fee for filing assessment appeal applications; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to establish a filing fee in connection with the processing of assessment appeal applications; and


WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors has proposed a fee schedule, which appeals consistent with applicable legal mandates, in a reasonable amount that is applied in a uniform manner; and

WHEREAS, a non-refundable filing fee of \$35 for each application/parcel will be charged and must be included at the time of filing the application. Payment can be made by check, money order, or cash. Make checks or money orders payable to: County of Plumas. If your check is returned due to insufficient funds, a returned check fee in the amount of \$20 will be charged. Applications submitted without the fee will not be processed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Plumas County Board of Supervisors hereby establishes a filing fee for assessment appeal applications in the amount of \$35 for each application filed with the Plumas County Board of Equalization.
