**A RESOLUTION DECREASING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS ON THE CHESTER CEMETERY DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES FROM FIVE TO THREE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees for the Chester Cemetery District currently consists of five members;

**WHEREAS**, there are presently two vacancies on the Board of Trustees for the Chester Cemetery District;

**WHEREAS**, the Chester Cemetery District has submitted a resolution requesting that the number of members on the Board of Trustees be decreased from five to three; and

**WHEREAS**, the Plumas County Board of Supervisors after publishing notice as required by law, has held a public hearing on this issue on today's date;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

The number of members on the Board of Trustees for the Chester Cemetery District is hereby decreased by two members, so that henceforth the Board of Trustees shall be composed of a total of three members. The reduction in membership shall result from the elimination of the two presently vacant positions on the Board of Trustees, and the three current members of the Board of Trustees shall continue their terms.


