WHEREAS the geotourism approach helps build a sense of identity and pride, stressing what is authentic and unique to Plumas County,




NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Plumas County Board of Supervisors supports the Sierra Nevada Geotourism Project.
