

SUGGESTED EMERGENCY WILDLAND FIRE EVACUATION ROUTES

Your evacuation route may change according to fire direction and fire behavior.
If in doubt, get out and notify your family or loved ones of your location


Proceed to the nearest community gate and exit the community via A-15 (Portola McLears Road).
As indicated in the red directional arrows (➔), take a travel direction on A-15 away from the emergency/wildfire.
