The Greenhorn Hazardous Fuels Reduction Project will reduce the risk of loss of life, property, and natural resources to wildfire on private and public lands within and adjacent to the project area and implement strategic fuel reduction on private property within Greenhorn Ranch, Spring Garden, and vicinity as identified in the Plumas County Community Wildfire Protection Plan. The project will remove small diameter trees on 149 acres of mixed conifer forest through mechanical mastication, hand thinning, and broadcast chipping.
