Project Title: Frontier Project 5320891, Plumas County, Old Haun Road

Project Location: T27N/R9E, Sec. 17, 21, and 28. The Project begins at the intersection of State Route 147 and Old Haun Road at latitude 40.199029° and longitude -121.071337° near Canyon Dam, Plumas County. Cable placement continues east along Old Haun Road for approximately 3.9 miles before the alignment turns south in the center of logging road for 0.3 miles. The Project then deviates 0.44 miles east along a dirt track before crossing Hauns Creek then joining up with another logging road east of the creek. The alignment follows the logging road for 0.81 miles where the Project resumes along Old Haun Road. Construction continues for 2.67 miles towards the city of Greenville. The Project ends near the intersection of State Route 89 and Old Haun Road. at latitude 40.168895° and longitude -120.96893°.

Description of Project: Restoration of internet service after the destruction by the Dixie Fire for residents and businesses by replacing an existing copper cable with broadband speed communication cable in the Plumas County service area, Greenville.
