Project Title: Quincy Channel Maintenance Project

Project Applicant: Plumas County Public Works Department

Project Location: The study area is located in the community of Quincy, Plumas County, California. It is shown on the Quincy, California 7.5-minute U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) quadrangle in Township 24 N, Range 9 E, Section 14. The approximate center of the study area is located at Universal Transverse Mercator (UTM) Zone 10 S, 676032E, 4423048N (NAD 83). A project location and vicinity map of the study area is provided in Exhibit A.

Description of Nature, Purpose or Beneficiaries of Project: The County will employ the California Conservation Corps. (CCC) to remove vegetation from the drainage ditches. The CCC will use hand tools (i.e., chainsaws and landscaping power tools) to trim vegetation out of the ditch channels while leaving the cut stem/trunk, root ball, and roots intact. Most vegetation along the banks will not be cut or trimmed; however, trimming will occur in areas where bank vegetation overhangs into the ditch and obstructs drainage. Vegetation removed during the project will either be stock piled and removed by the County, or chipped and broadcast into upland areas located along the shoulder of the paved bike path. Refueling of power tools (chainsaws, etc.) will occur at least 50 feet away from drainage ditches to ensure no accidental spill of pollutants (e.g., fuel, oil, and grease). No heavy equipment will be utilized, and no excavation or discharge of fill material is proposed.
