
## **Recommendations:**

***Recommendation R2.*** *“The Civil Grand Jury recommends the Election Division seek, the County Administrator consider recommending, and the Board Of Supervisors deliberate and consider approving, the funding for the purchase and installation of new voting system equipment and software in order to comply with AP 19:020.”*

**Response:** This recommendation has not yet been implemented, but will be implemented in the future. The Board of Supervisors is aware of the need and requirement to update our current voting systems. The Board of Supervisors is also aware that the County Elections Division is working on fulfilling this requirement. It is estimated this process should be completed prior to December 31, 2019.
