






CONSTRUCTION OF MONUMENT

CAP IS PINNED ONTO 1 1/2" ID  
GALVANIZED PIPE 4.5' FEET  
LONG.

SET IN PLACE OF ORIGINAL  
ROCK MOUND. ROCKS WERE  
CAREFULLY REMOVED TO  
EXCAVATE HOLE. MAGNET  
WAS SET AT BOTTOM OF HOLE.  
ROCKS WERE ALSO PUT JUST  
BELOW SURFACE AND ORIGINAL  
ROCK MOUND WAS PLACED  
AROUND PIPE, AS NEAR TO  
ORIGINAL PLACEMENT AS  
POSSIBLE.



