HeartSafe Community

- Update from Central Plumas
 - Elaine and Sam able to get AED in all S.O. patrol vehicle throughout the county
 - Still working on I.V. letter of intent- unable to host CPR classes
- AED Registration- there is map through Pulse Point app and anyone can register AED in their community
 - All Lake Almanor AED are on Pulse Point, except new AED in catholic church
- Letter of Intent received from EPHC Ambulance:
 - Still working on application process
 - 2 more AED to be placed very soon
 - Elaine will work on getting AED registered by end of next week
 - Corina is working on getting public trained- slowing plugging away at it due to COVID
- No update from Lake Almanor Area

Health Care Coalition (Tri-HCC):

- The Tri-HCC next meeting is on May 5, 2021 at 10:00 am.
- On April 1, 2021, the rough draft of Infectious Disease Annex was uploaded into the CAT

- Plumas County received additional funding for local hospitals and EMS related to COVID-19 and was able to purchase equipment/supplies for those who requested.
