

**A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE PROCLAMATION OF A COUNTY-WIDE LOCAL EMERGENCY DUE TO SIGNIFICANT IMPACTS OF THE CAMP FIRE IN SUPPORT OF BUTTE COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, Section 4-1.05 of the Plumas County Code empowers Director of the Office of Emergency Services to proclaim a local emergency when the county is affected or threatened by an event causing great damage, possible loss of life, or other public calamity and the Board of Supervisors is not in session; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 10, 2018 the Director of Emergency Services proclaimed a local emergency due to the Camp Fire in Butte County affecting Plumas County, and

**WHEREAS**, at the request of Butte County has activated the Emergency Operations Center as well as two Evacuation Centers in Plumas County. and;

These conditions are or are likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of said County of Plumas, and;

**WHEREAS**, Section 4-1.05 of the Plumas County Code requires the Board of Supervisors to ratify the emergency proclamation within seven (7) days or the proclamation will no longer be in force,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Plumas County Board of Supervisors hereby ratifies the declaration of a local emergency due to the significant, ongoing and possibly undiscovered impacts due to the Camp Fire in Butte County.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, Plumas County Board of Supervisors shall review the need for continuing the local emergency at least every month and shall terminate the emergency as soon as local conditions warrant.

**The forgoing resolution was duly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Plumas, State of California at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors on November 13, 2018 by the following vote:**
