Project Title: Quincy-LaPorte Road Emergency Repair Project

Project Applicant: Plumas County Department of Public Works

Project Location: The proposed project area is located on Quincy-LaPorte Road approximately 0.3 mile north of the Middle Fork Feather River and approximately five miles southeast of Quincy in Plumas County, California. It is shown on the *Blue Nose Mountain, California* 7.5-minute U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) quadrangle in Township 23 North, Range 10 East, Section 10. The approximate center of the proposed project is located at latitude 39.865862°, longitude -120.850007°. See attached map.

Description of Nature, Purpose or Beneficiaries of Project: The proposed project will reconstruct Quincy-LaPorte Road to its original alignment (Figure 2). The number of through-traffic lanes will not increase, and the roadway profile will stay at the same elevation as the existing road. The proposed project will reconstruct the damaged road embankment to its original footprint. From Station 24+00 to 28+00, the full width of the structural section will be replaced with aggregate base and hot mix asphalt. At other locations, damaged asphalt will be sawcut, removed, and replaced with hot mix asphalt. The ditch line will be restored to pre-storm event conditions. The restored road will meet current design standards of Plumas County, American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials, and Caltrans.

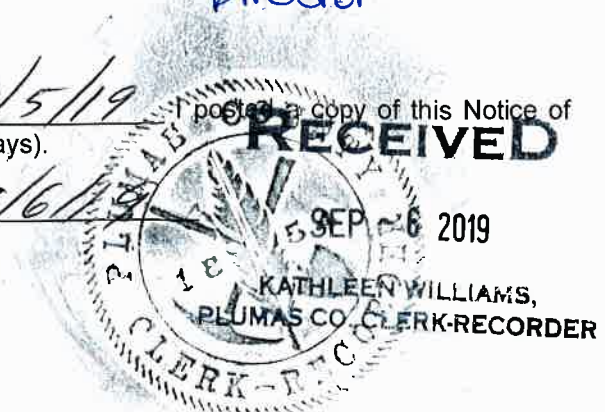

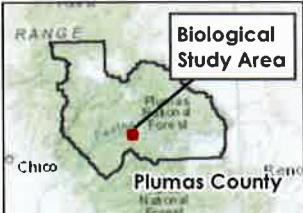
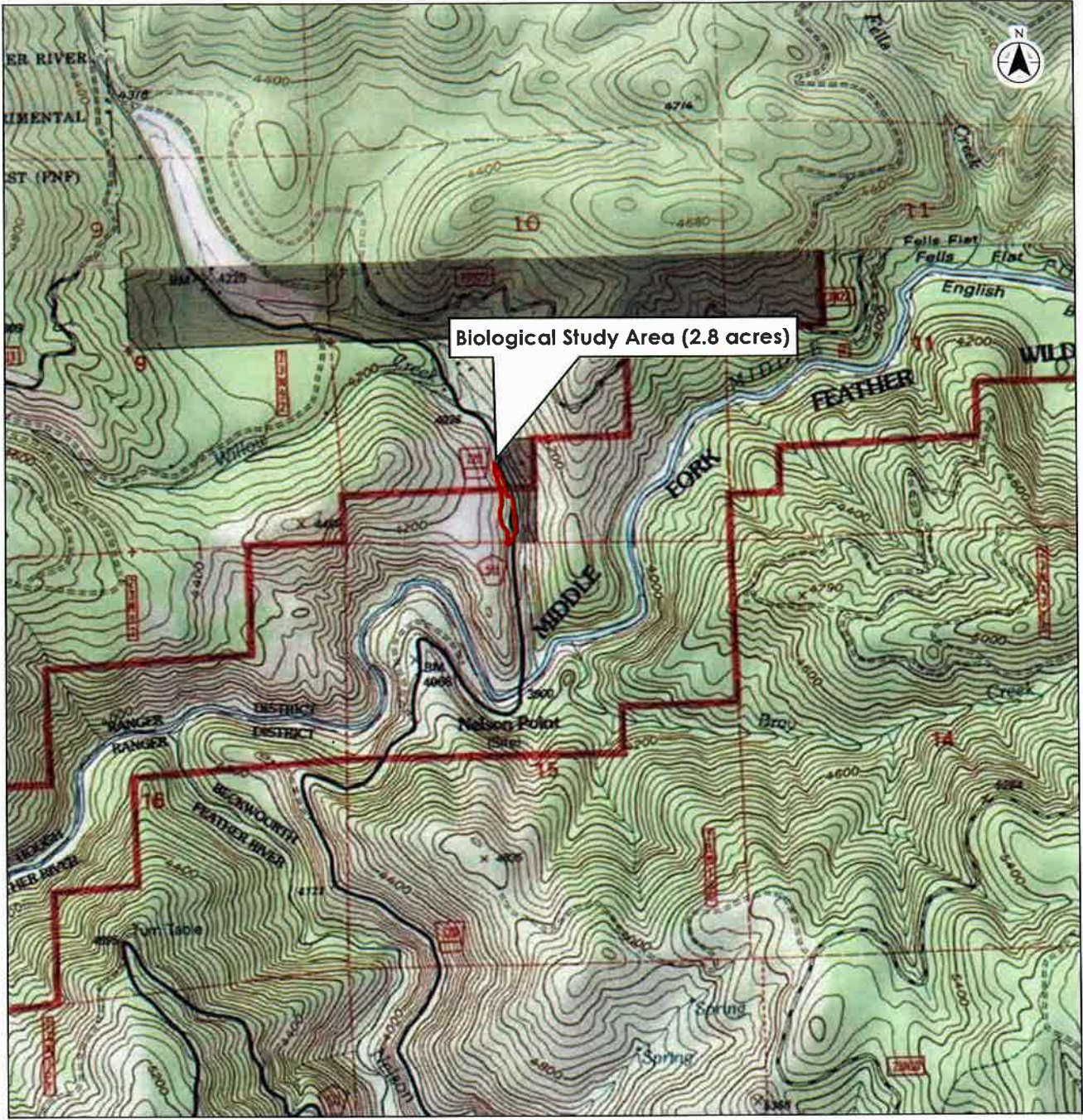
