Appeal of the Zoning Administrator's certification of Final Environmental Impact Report Number 84 for the Lake Front at Walker Ranch Planned Development Permit, Vesting Tentative Subdivision Map and Development Agreement.

Intent to Temporarily Suspend County Code 4-3.203

Motion by Supervisor Simpson, second by Supervisor Olsen and carried, intent to temporarily suspend County Code 4-3.203, a commercial vehicle weight restriction over a portion of Bucks Lake Road; and direct County Counsel to determine if a formal process to suspend is required.

PLEDGE OF REVENUE – CHESTER LANDFILL
