Public Notice – Risk Management Plan Available for Public Review and Comment California Accidental Release Prevention (CalARP) Program Graeagle Water Company Treatment Plant

Graeagle, CA – As required by the California Accidental Release Prevention program, the Graeagle Water Company has submitted a Risk Management Plan (RMP) dated July 17, 2019 to Environmental Health for review. An RMP is required based on the volume of acutely hazardous materials used at their water treatment facility, namely gaseous chlorine. Environmental Health has reviewed the RMP and determined that the submittal is complete according to the Title 19 of the California Code of Regulations Section 2745.2(a). In accordance with Section 2745.2(c) of this code, this plan is now available for public review and comment.

The public review and comment period is 45 days from the date of this notice. Although the document cannot be shared electronically or posted online, any interested party may schedule an appointment to review this plan at the Environmental Health office located at 270 County Hospital Road, Suite 127, Quincy. The office is open Monday through Friday, 8AM to 5PM but again an appointment is required.

Environmental Health will accept written comments until 5PM September 23, 2019 regarding this RMP. Please direct comments to:
