**East Quincy Transfer Station – News Release**

**Subject:** Temporary Relocation and Construction of Recycling Facility

**Location:** East Quincy Transfer Station

**Duration:** October 7-18, 2019

Summary: Public Works construction crews are scheduled to start on Oct. 7, 2019 at the East Quincy Transfer Station with the demolition of existing fencing in order to relocate the recycle center closer to the Transfer Station operation and attendant booth. Construction activities force the temporary relocation of the recycling bins to inside the transfer station operation. Due to the limited available space and the smaller bin size used during this two week period, Public Works Solid Waste Division requests that customers limit their recycling activity if possible during this period. The transfer station hours will remain the same through-out construction activity. Please be respectful of the temporary construction fencing that the construction crews that will be on-site at this location. Construction is anticipated to be completed by October 18, 2019 and the new recycling configuration will open soon after.


