Hello Plumas County LHMP Planning Team:

I wanted to thank everyone who joined the Zoom meeting yesterday for the LHMP Risk Assessment. It was a great success! As the consultant team, we are extremely impressed with the engagement and input by all of you into this process – Thank you!

We received a lot of great information both during the meeting and through follow-up emails. Keep your input coming – all of the information will add greatly to the Hazard Risk Assessment for Plumas. I am again attaching the Plumas Historic Hazard Worksheet that you can use to document past hazard occurrences, issues, problem areas, etc. And, if you have other documents, plans, emails, studies, etc. with information, please forward those or provide us a link and tell us what we should be looking for.

As discussed yesterday, our next steps include:

--a Draft Risk Assessment Chapter will be provided to the planning team the first week of May.

--our next meetings, the Mitigation Strategy Meetings, are scheduled for May 19 and 20, 2020. These are usually two, 3-hour meetings to develop mitigation goals and actions/projects for the updated LHMP. The meeting format will likely be done via Zoom meetings. We are determining the best way to conduct these meetings online to best facilitate your input. We will get back to you with specific details when we know them.

--the LHMP is still on schedule to be submitted to Cal OES and FEMA the end of August 2020.
