In preparation for next week's **Plumas County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan update Mitigation Strategy meetings**, please be aware of the following:

Note, the Risk Assessment working draft is being provided for informational purposes in order to see what information we have and what information we don't have. It still needs to go through a review and edit process as part of our later LHMP review drafts. You'll notice a few gaps and we are working to incorporate additional information. **Anything highlighted in yellow are areas where we still need some local input from the planning team. The green highlighting are items for Foster Morrison to complete.** Please take some time to review in advance of our meetings next week.

These are the two most important meetings for this plan:

Tuesday, May 19 (1:30 - 4:30 pm) - during the first meeting, we will be briefly revisiting the risk assessment data developed to date and will again be looking for your feedback in refining and adding to this in-process Risk Assessment Chapter. We will also be establishing plan goals and objectives.

Wednesday, May 20 (9am - noon) - during the second meeting, you will be working to identify and evaluate potential mitigation actions for reducing Plumas County's risk and vulnerability to identified hazards and disasters.
