

NOTICE OF CURRENT PROPERTY TAXES DUE
Made pursuant to Sections 2609 & 2610, Revenue and Taxation Code

The Plumas County Tax Collector has mailed Secured property tax bills to all property owners at the address of record on the tax roll. If you own property in Plumas County and did not receive a tax bill, contact the tax collector's office, at 520 West Main Street, Room 203, Quincy, or call (530) 283 – 6260. Tax bills can also be viewed and printed from our website by visiting www.plumascounty.us/ttc. **Failure to receive a tax bill does not relieve the taxpayer of the responsibility to make timely payments.**

The first installment of 2020 - 2021 taxes, are due and payable on November 1st, 2020 and will become delinquent if not paid in the office or postmarked **by 5 p.m. on December 10, 2020**. The second installment is due on February 1st, 2021 and will become delinquent if not paid in the office or postmarked **by 5 p.m. on April 10, 2021**, thereafter a 10% penalty and a twenty dollar cost will be added. Both installments may be paid when the first installment is due.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Tax Collector's office could be closed to the public. If the office is closed to the public, there is a payment drop box outside the Tax Collector's office, Room 203, for non-cash payments, cash payments can be made by appointment by calling (530) 283-6260. There is also a payment drop box for all non-cash payments located outside the front entrance to the Courthouse on Main Street. Payments can be mailed to P.O. Box 176, Quincy, CA 95971 or by credit card. **To pay by credit card visit www.plumascounty.us/ttc.** There will be a fee charged for this service as set by the credit card agency Point and Pay.
