I, B.F. BARBEE, hereby certify that I am a Licensed Land Surveyor of the State of California; that I am one of the two surveyors who jointly surveyed the Additional Townsite to the Town of Greenville and filed the original and amended official maps of said Additional Townsite; that the basis of bearings of said survey and maps was a Polaris observation; that the property corners within said Additional Townsite were marked by then-existing fence corners and not by surveyors' monuments; and that I am of the opinion that the West quarter corner of Section 2 shown on this map is the identical monument used as a basis by me for my survey of said Additional Townsite.
