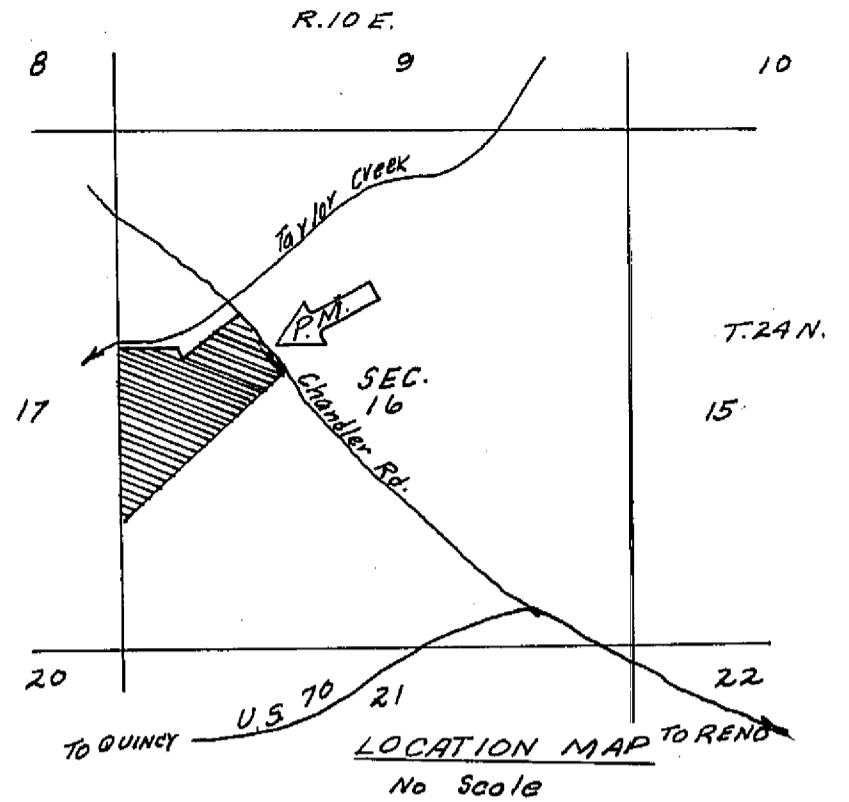

NOTES

1. Tentative Parcel Map approved by Plumas County Planning Commission June 1, 1971.
2. Easement No. 1. A 30-ft. easement for possible future road widening reserved by owner, together with the right to convey to others. (Easement No. 1 is also to include the operation and maintenance of existing irrigation ditches.)
3. Easement No. 2. A 15-ft. easement reserved by owner for the operation and maintenance of an existing irrigation ditch, together with the right to convey to others.
4. Easement No. 3. A 40-ft. easement for roadway, utilities and incidental purposes for the benefit of Parcels 1 and 4.
5. Easement No. 4. A 20-ft. easement for roadway, utilities and incidental purposes for the benefit of Parcel 4.
6. Easement No. 5. A 10-ft. easement reserved by Ernest G. Leonhardt in deed from Leonhardt to Cal-Sierra Title Co. (O.R. Bk. 200, p. 113) for the operation and maintenance of an existing irrigation ditch.
7. The limits of Greenhorn Creek indicated on the map are the extreme high banks above which there is no evidence of flooding in recent severe floods.
8. Floor elevation of dwellings subject to approval of Plumas Co. Surveyor-Engineer and Bldg. Official.
9. The construction of a bridge, or other channel crossing, of Greenhorn Creek subject to approval of Plumas Co. Surveyor-Engineer and Bldg. Official.
