Access to subject property at the time of County approval is solely by a road subject to the jurisdiction of the United States Department of Agriculture, and maintenance is not guaranteed.

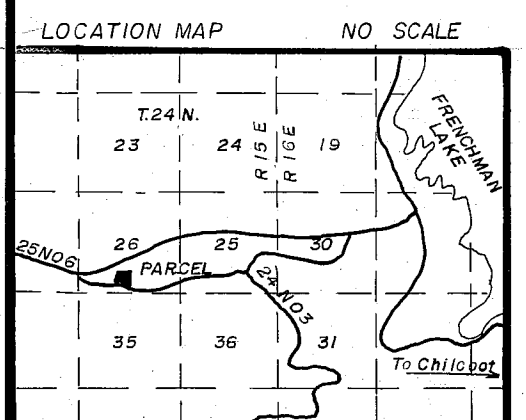

Leach exclusion areas are all areas within 50' of property lines, within easements, within 50' of water courses and all areas with slopes in excess of 30%.
