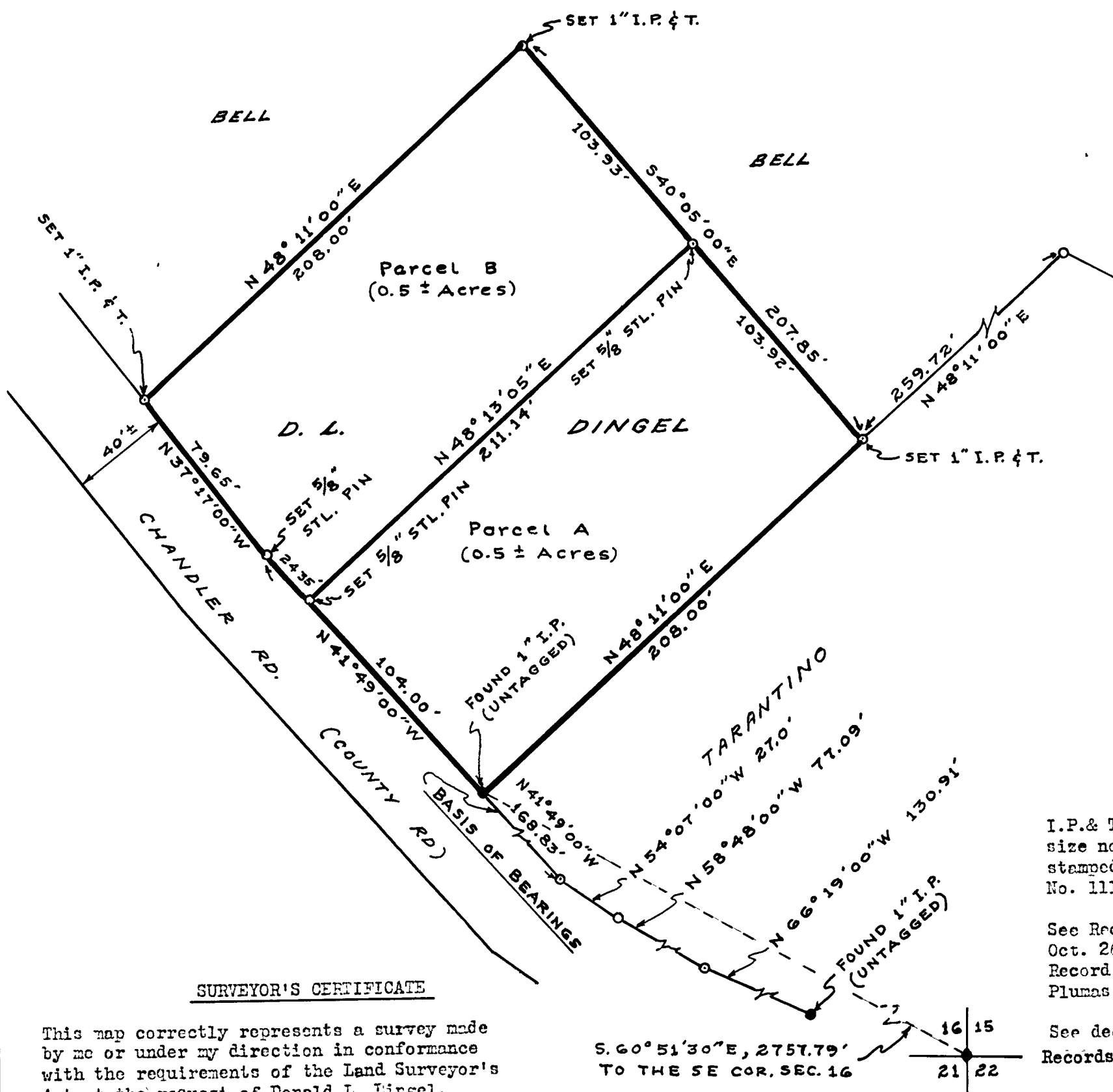


SEC. 16, T. 24 N., R. 10 E. (M.D.M.)
