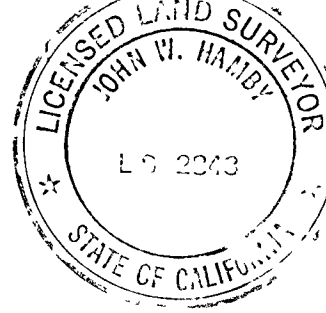
The purpose of this survey is to establish the East line of the property indicated by hatch lines.

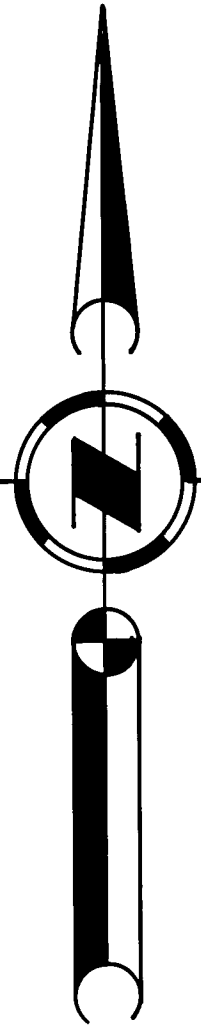
