

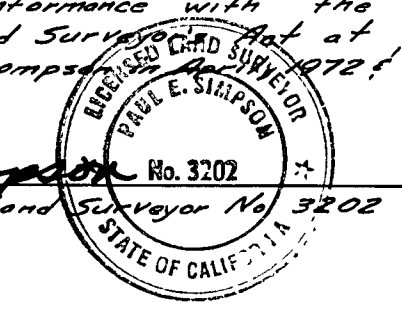
Found 1/2" iron pipe at approx. location of Rec. Hwy. ties.
 Found 1/2" iron pipe in 5' x 5' x 5' concrete mound. Located by G.L.O. notes U.S. 2702. (G.L.O. Record ties for B.T.'s, a 6" Oak bears $N49^{\circ}46'19''E$, a 6" Oak bears $N34^{\circ}14'W$, a 5" Oak bears $N34^{\circ}14'W$, a 4" Oak bears $S27^{\circ}12'W$ 12' 3")

Reset Section Cor. from G.L.O. tape calls. Set 1" iron pipe tagged "L.S. 3202" at Feather River West 556' & a small creek is North 221'. From Sec. Cor. a 12" Oak bears $S67^{\circ}08'19''E$, remains of an old Oak bears $N34^{\circ}W$ 12', a depression in ground with wood remnants bears $S27^{\circ}W$ 12' (G.L.O. Record ties for B.T.'s, a 6" Oak bears $N49^{\circ}46'19''E$, a 6" Oak bears $N34^{\circ}14'W$ 12', a 5" Oak bears $N34^{\circ}14'W$ 12', a 4" Oak bears $S27^{\circ}12'W$ 12' 3")
