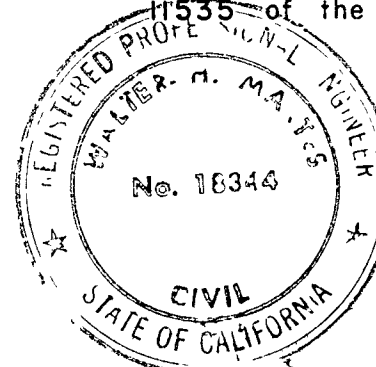


NOTE:
