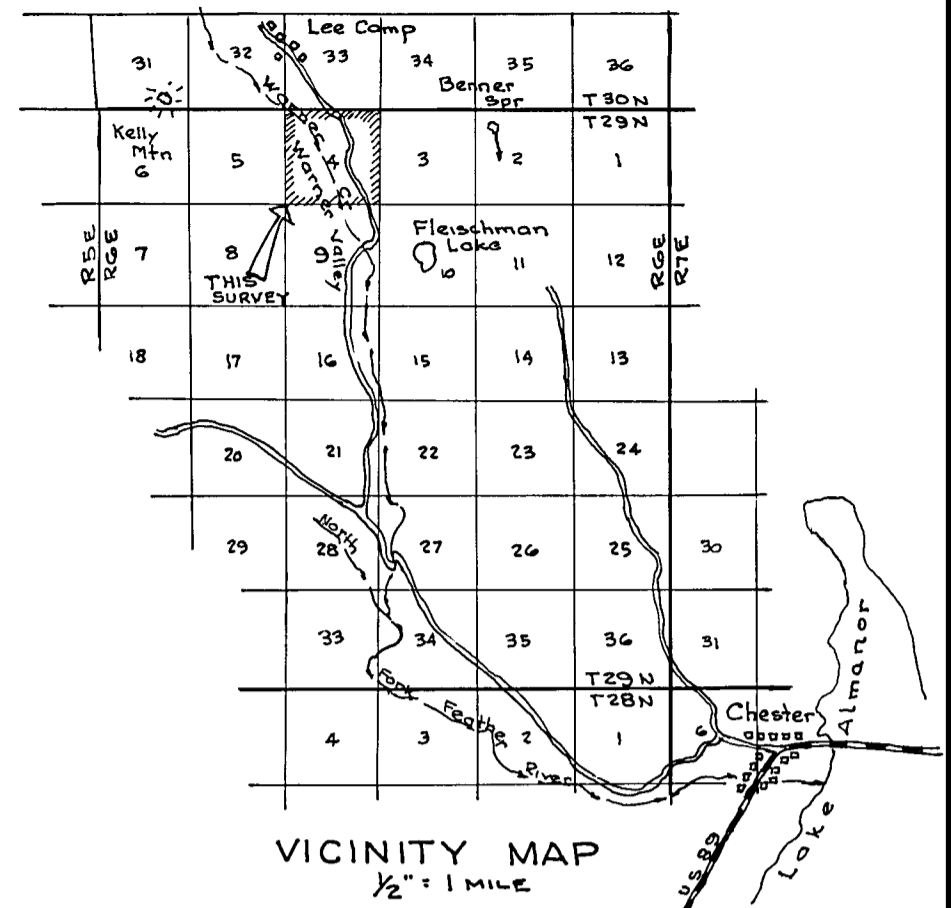


LEGEND

 2. A mound of rocks surrounds all pipes set in this survey except the NE cor. of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4, which falls in water at the face of a beaver dam, and the SE cor. of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4, which falls in a tree.
