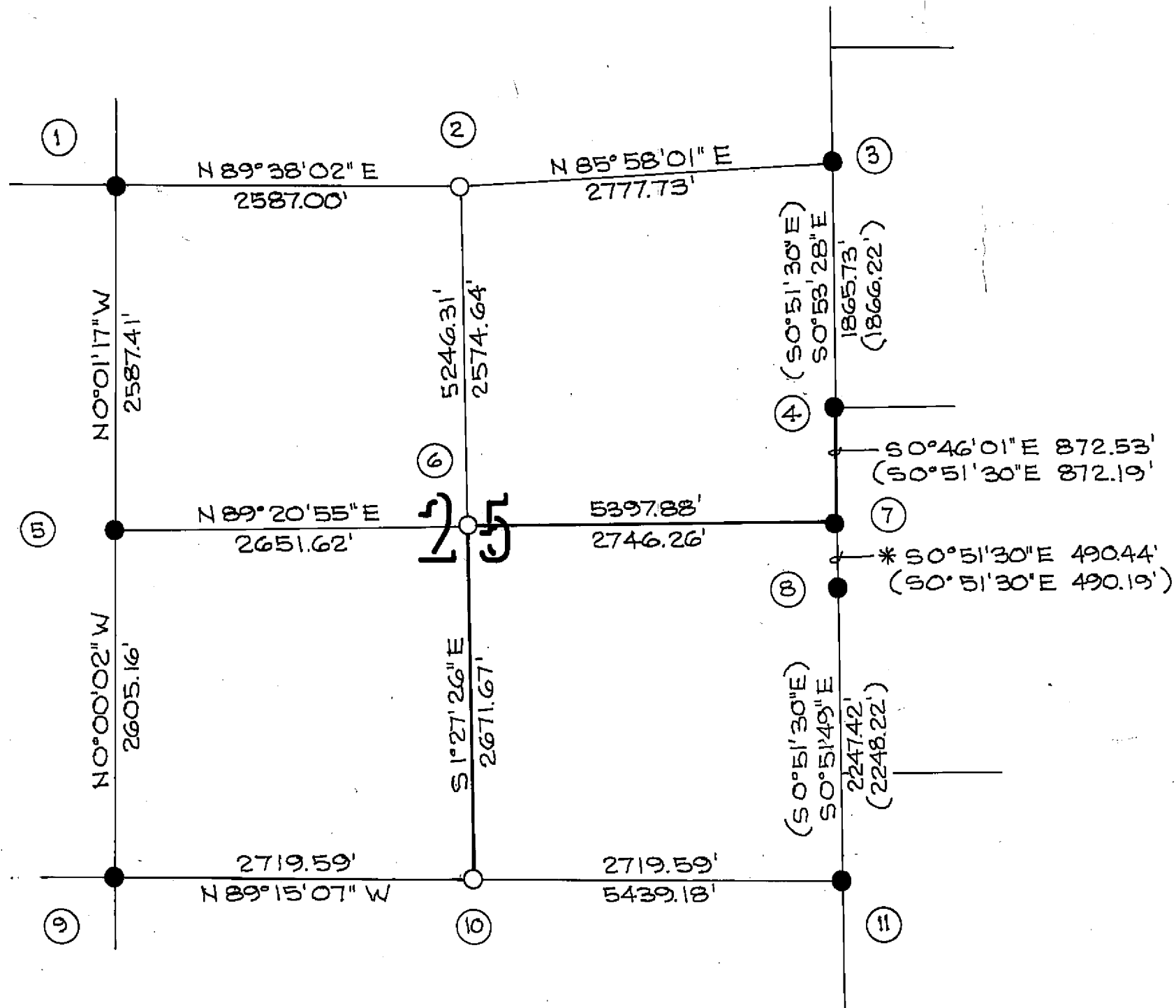


CORNER NOTES



- ① Found U.S.F.S. A.C.A.P. in M.O.S. and 15" Ponderosa Pine S53 1/2° E 20.5' 15" Cedar N74 3/4° E 32.3' 25" Douglas Fir N12° E 26.7' 18" Ponderosa Pine S23° E 32.5' 17" Ponderosa Pine N4° E 26.0'
- ② Found M.O.S. Set A.C.A.P. in M.O.S. and marked 6" Black Oak S3° E 5.2' 8" Cedar N39° E 7.1'
- ③ Found B.L.M. B.C.I.P. in M.O.S. and 18" Black Oak S75° W 13.5' (orig.) 29" Ponderosa Pine S58° E 7.9' (orig.) 5" Cedar S12° W 14.2' 7" Douglas Fir N30° W 5.6'
- ④ Found B.L.M. B.C.I.P. in M.O.S. and 12" Douglas Fir N39° E 23.0' 18" Sugar Pine S24 1/2° E 28.7'
