GENERAL NOTES

1. This Project was called Small Cadastral Survey and was accomplished for Lassen National Forest under contract No. 53-9jnc-2-66.
2. All monuments were provided by the U.S.F.S. Corner identification was stamped on the cap per 1973 BLM "Manual of Instruction". L.S. 6344 was also stamped on the cap.

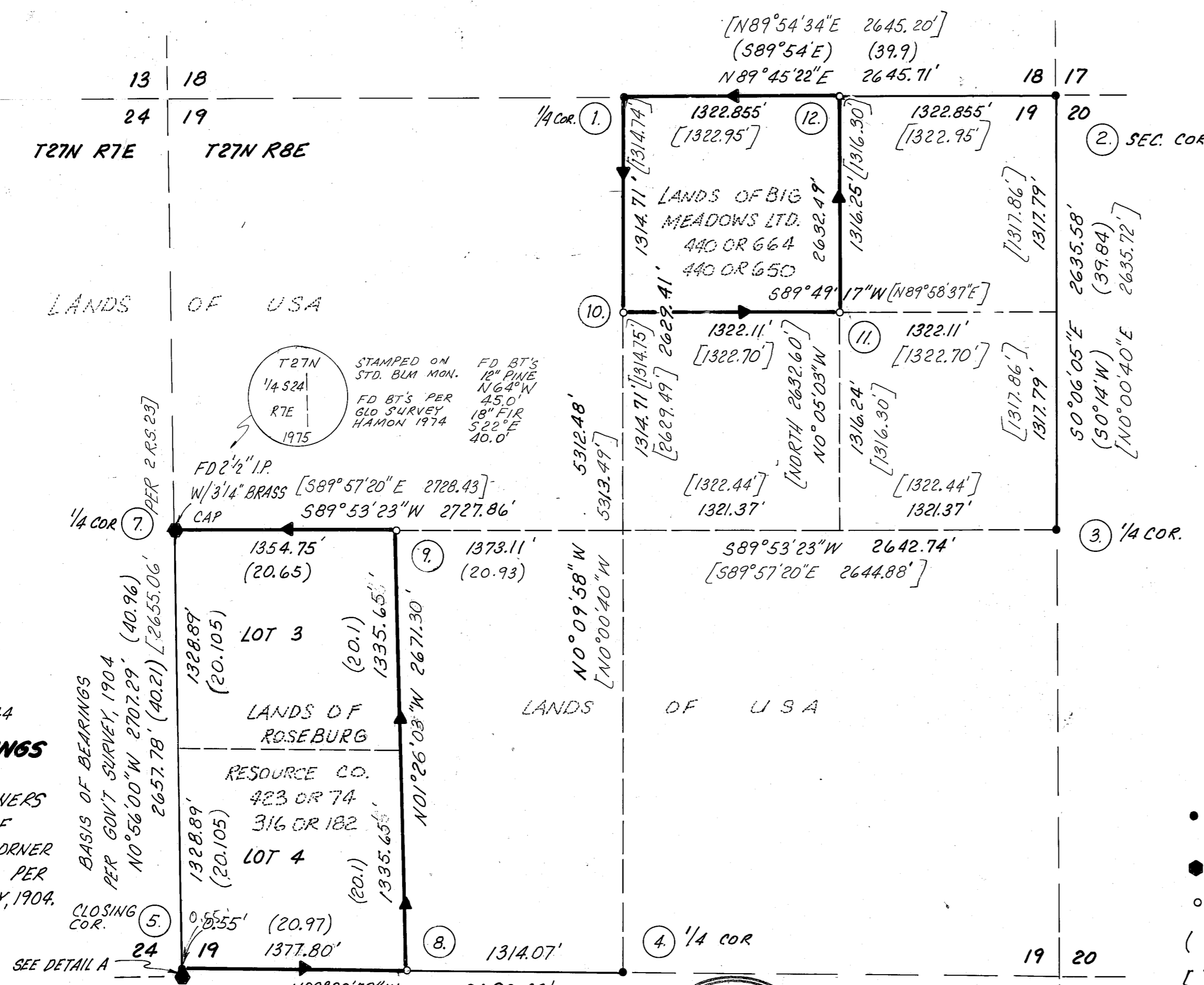
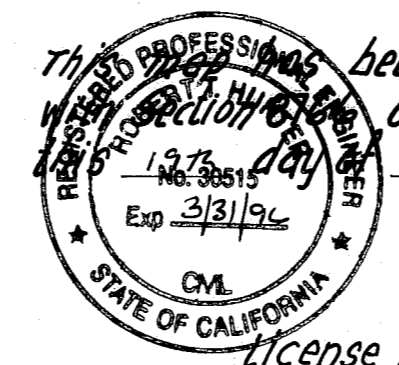

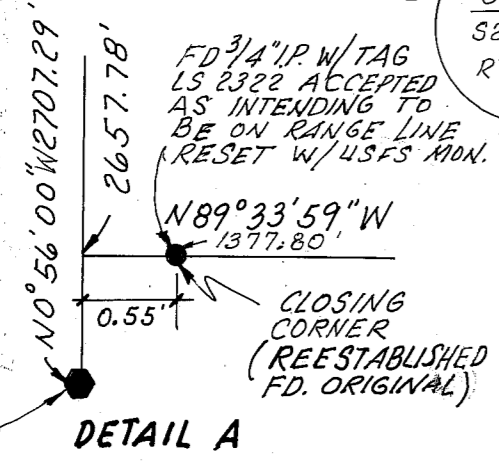
