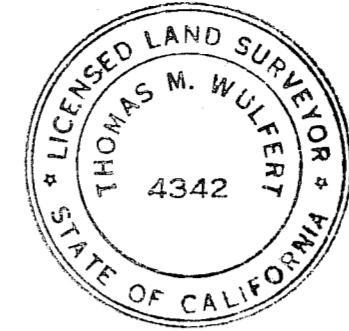

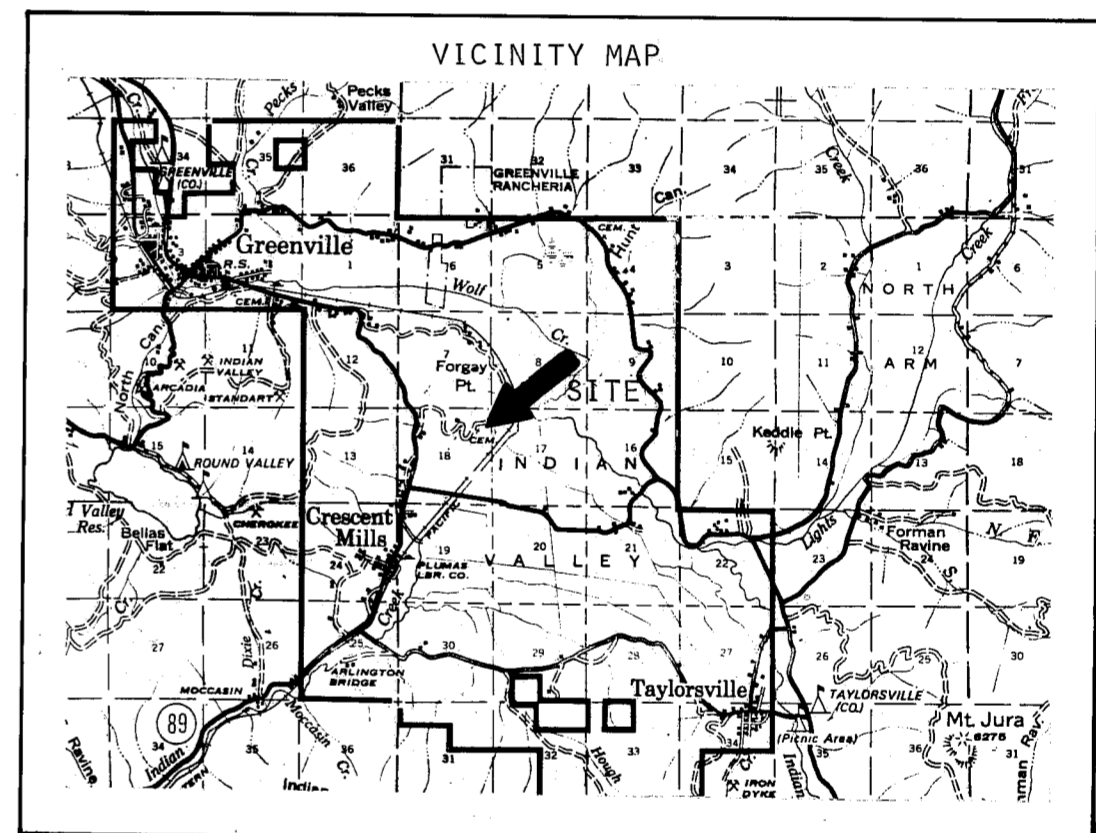

**Surveyors Notes**

1. The north 1/4 of Section 18 was established for this calculation by going west 40.22 chains from the NE corner of Section 18 (per S&O survey).
2. Record Deed Calls were used, which resulted in the 118.4' overlap between the North-South lines.
3. The information regarding the location and California State Plane Coordinates (Zone 1) of the Southwest corner of swamp and overflow lands survey No. 80 was furnished by the Plumas County Surveyor.
4. This is an existing blazed line shown to the Court' during field review.
5. The section corner is of record as noted. The original call is for a rock mnd. and scribed post. Scribing mentioned is a portion of a tree bole marked in a fashion that may have been done by a timber cruiser or others during early logging operations. There is no evidence that this is an original G.L.O. corner.
