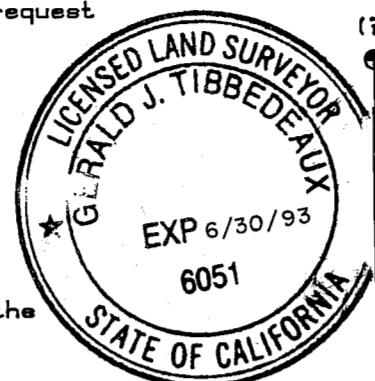

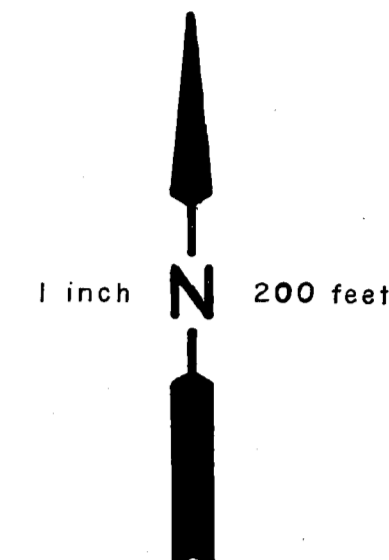
BASIS OF BEARINGS

The bearing of N 89° 51' 00" E for the North line of Section 12, T. 25 N., R. 7 E., M.D.M. recorded in the 1939 G.L.O. Notes of the Subdivision of T. 25 N., R. 7 E., as found monumented, was taken as the basis of bearings shown on this map.

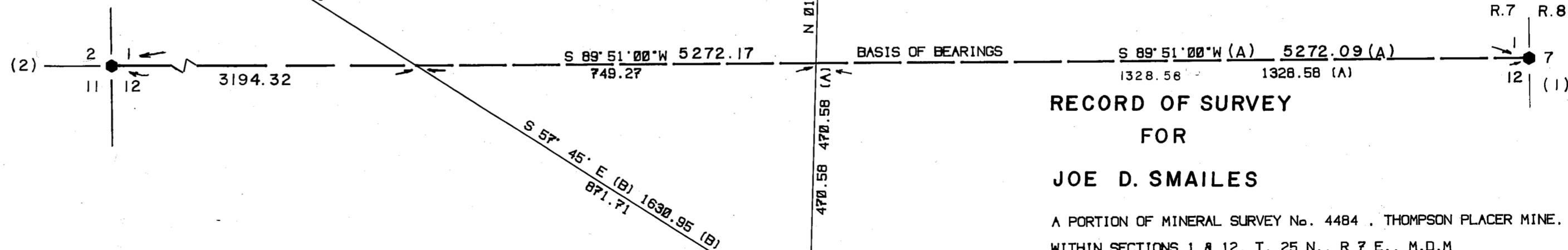
