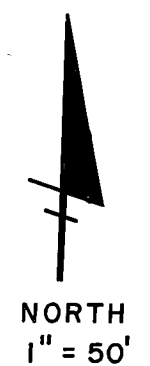
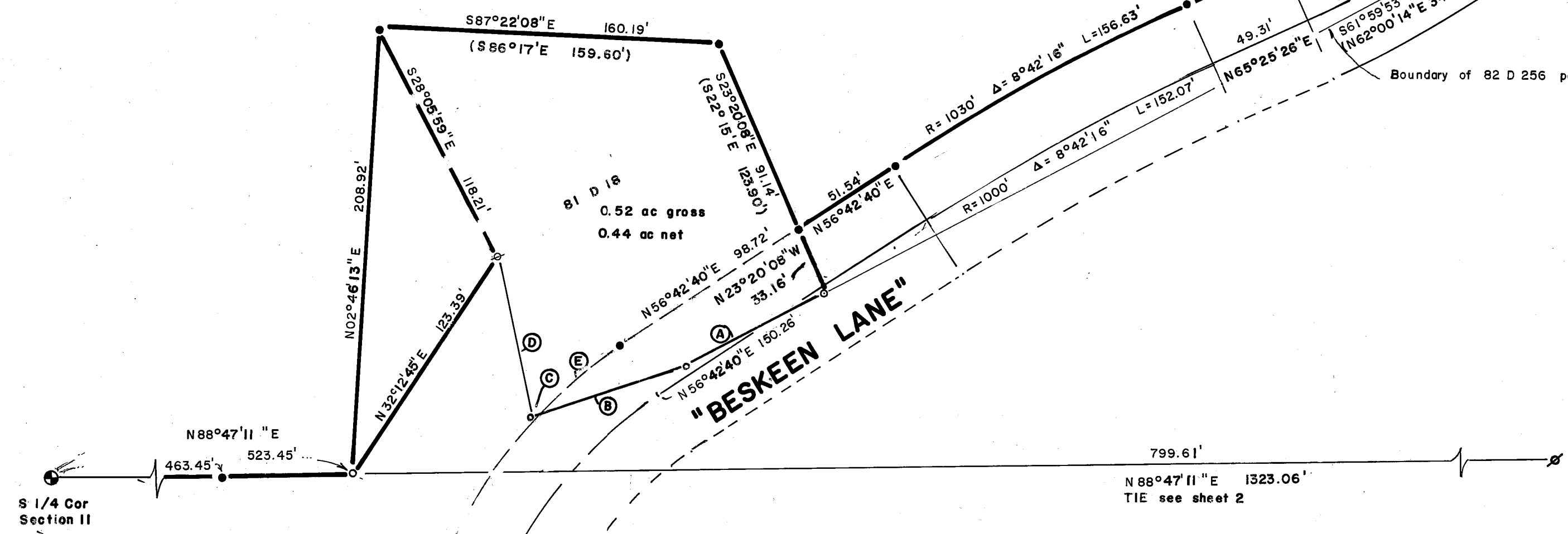
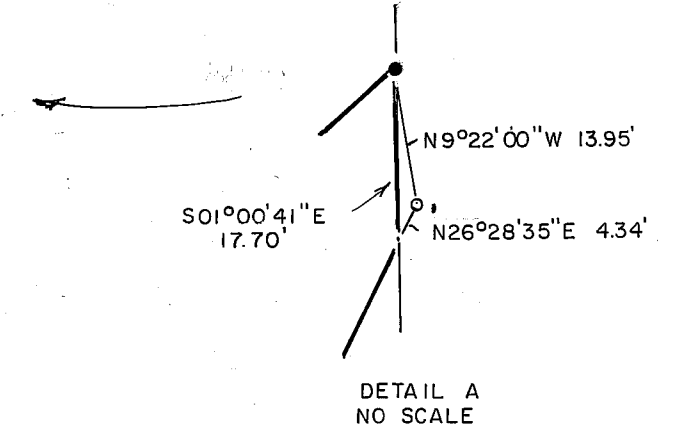


Location Map

near Quincy, Plumas County, California



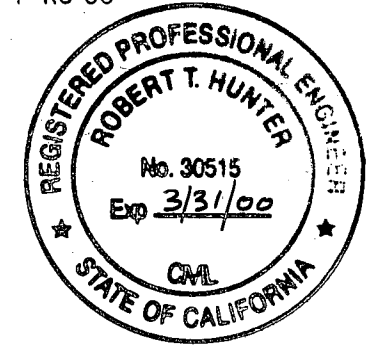
