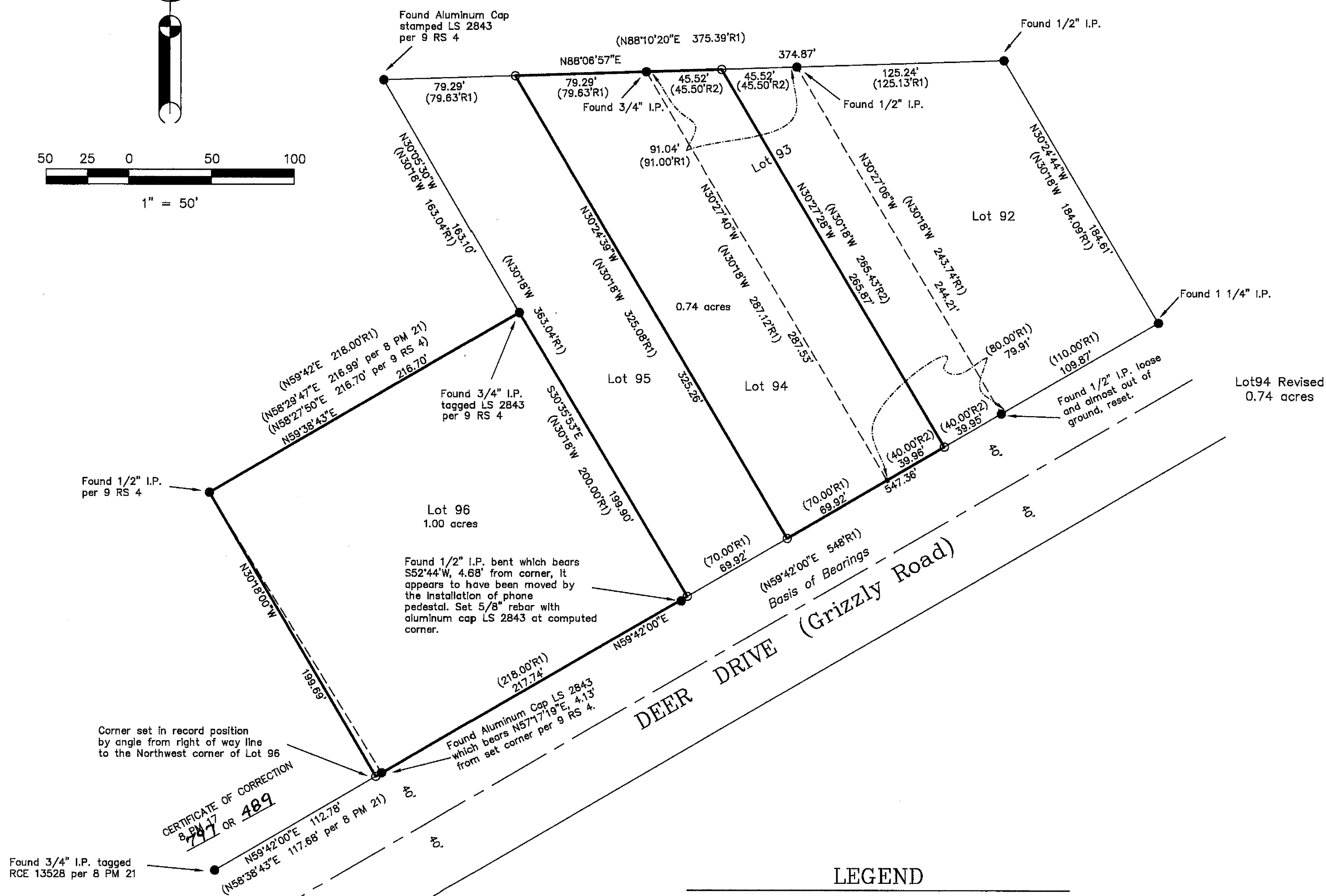
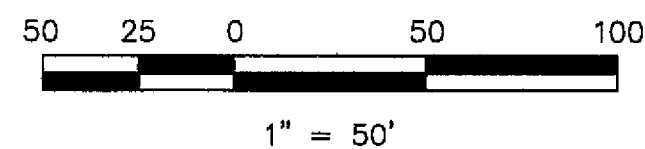


Basis of Bearings

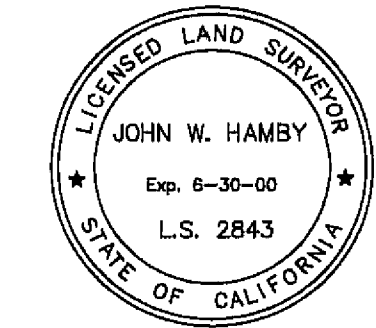

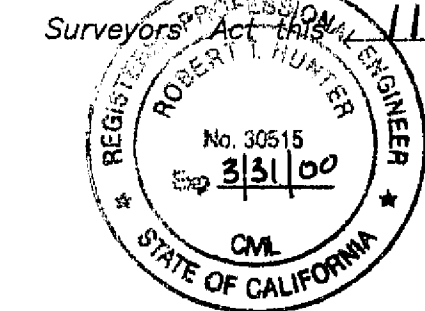
