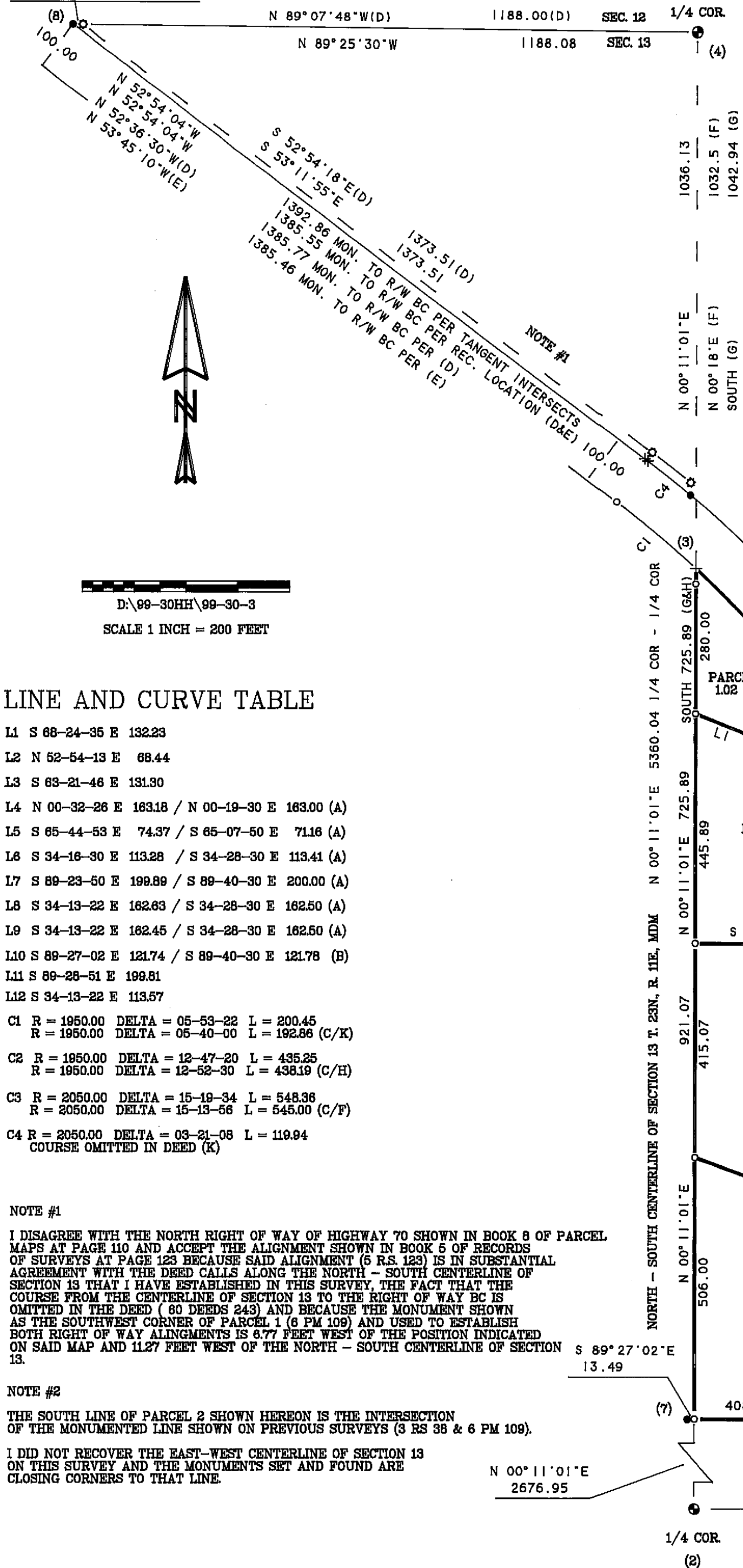

NOTE #1

I DISAGREE WITH THE NORTH RIGHT OF WAY OF HIGHWAY 70 SHOWN IN BOOK 8 OF PARCEL MAPS AT PAGE 110 AND ACCEPT THE ALIGNMENT SHOWN IN BOOK 5 OF RECORDS OF SURVEYS AT PAGE 123 BECAUSE SAID ALIGNMENT (5 R.S. 123) IS IN SUBSTANTIAL AGREEMENT WITH THE DEED CALLS ALONG THE NORTH - SOUTH CENTERLINE OF SECTION 13 THAT I HAVE ESTABLISHED IN THIS SURVEY, THE FACT THAT THE COURSE FROM THE CENTERLINE OF SECTION 13 TO THE RIGHT OF WAY BC IS OMITTED IN THE DEED (60 DEEDS 243) AND BECAUSE THE MONUMENT SHOWN AS THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF PARCEL 1 (6 PM 109) AND USED TO ESTABLISH BOTH RIGHT OF WAY ALIGNMENTS IS 6.77 FEET WEST OF THE POSITION INDICATED ON SAID MAP AND 11.27 FEET WEST OF THE NORTH - SOUTH CENTERLINE OF SECTION 13.

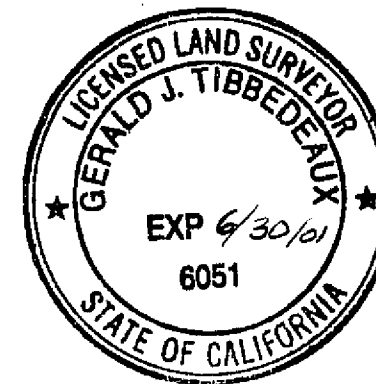
NOTE #2

THE SOUTH LINE OF PARCEL 2 SHOWN HEREON IS THE INTERSECTION OF THE MONUMENTED LINE SHOWN ON PREVIOUS SURVEYS (3 RS 38 & 6 PM 109).

I DID NOT RECOVER THE EAST-WEST CENTERLINE OF SECTION 13 ON THIS SURVEY AND THE MONUMENTS SET AND FOUND ARE CLOSING CORNERS TO THAT LINE.
