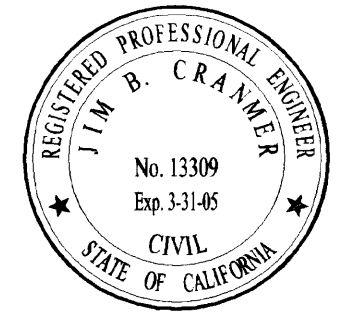

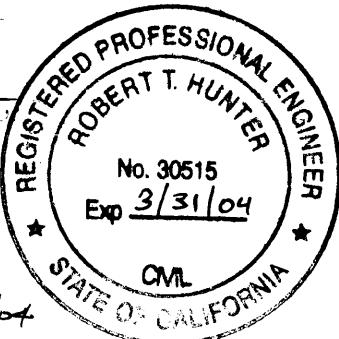

 THE BASIS OF BEARINGS OF THIS SURVEY IS TRUE NORTH DERIVED FROM G. P. S. OBSERVATIONS AT POINT NUMBERS 21 AND 22, YIELDING A BEARING OF N89°31'57" E (LINE # 30). ALL DISTANCES SHOWN ON SHEET 2 AS "MEASURED" ARE HORIZONTAL GROUND DISTANCES.

- 1) ESTABLISHED N. E. CLOSING CORNER OF SECTION 3 BY SINGLE PROPORTION. USING G. L. O. THE DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF 1926, OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T. 22 N. R. 7 E.
 - 2) ESTABLISHED A POINT BY SINGLE PROPORTION ON LINE BETWEEN THE FOUND N.W. CLOSING CORNER OF SECTION 3 AND THE RESET THE N.E. CLOSING CORNER OF SECTION 3, THEN FROM SAID POINT NORTH TO THE TOWNSHIP LINE TO ESTABLISH THE N. 1/4 OF SECTION 3.
 - 3) SEE SHEET # 2 FOR MONUMENT LEGEND AND LINE TABLES FOR BEARINGS AND DISTANCES, RECORD AND MEASURED.
