

BASIS OF BEARINGS

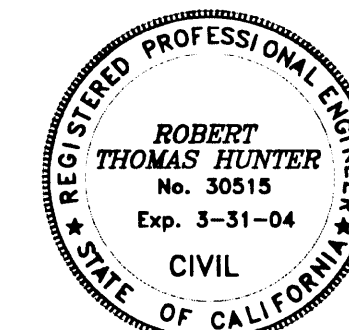

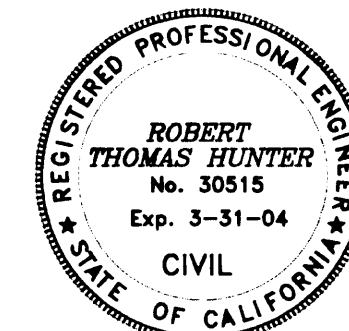

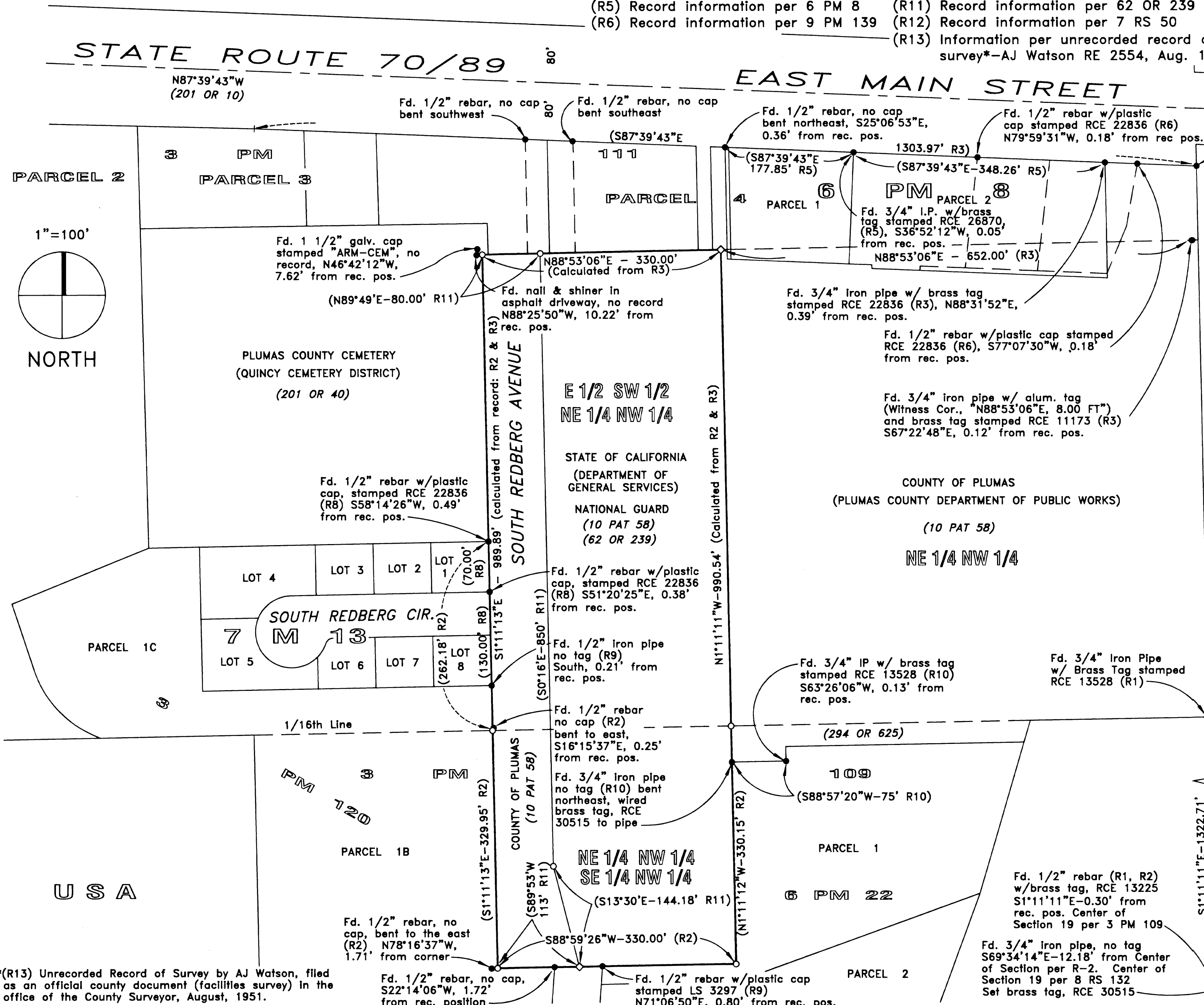
