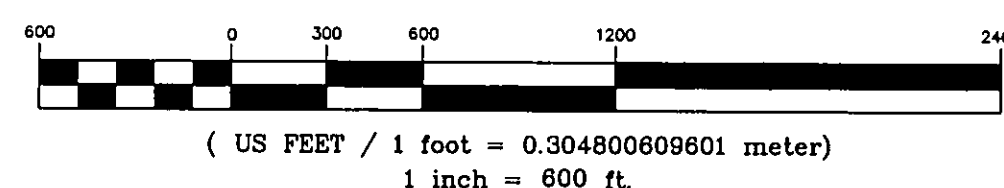

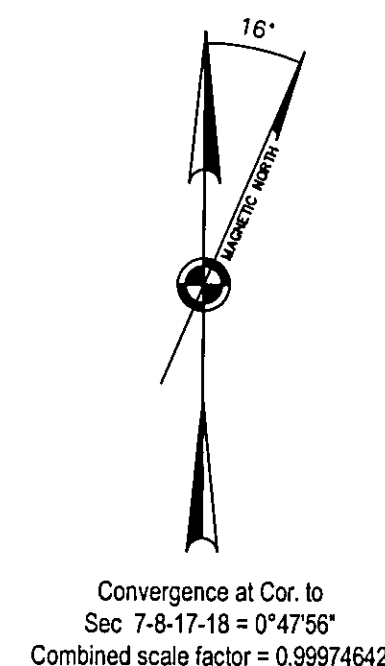

The Basis of Bearing was derived from GPS observations. State Plane Coordinates (CGS83 Zone 1) were calculated and then converted to ground bearing and distances using the given convergence angle and combined scale factor.



NARRATIVE - SECTION 7, T. 24 N., R. 11 E.

History

1871 - A.W. Keddie surveyed the range line between Ranges 10 & 11 East.

1880 - Wm. Minto resurveyed the range line and subdivided the township setting closing corners.

1969 - Adam Sydlik, Cadastral Surveyor, BLM, remonumented several corners in the township.

1984 - Robert Granberger, LS 5287, surveyed the range line between the East quarter corner of Section 12 only (R 10 E) and the Section corner between Sections 12 & 13. He set the South sixteenth corner for Section 12 only (R 10 E). See 6 RS 120.

Procedure

The closing corner between Sections 6 & 7, had been found and remonumented in its original position in 1969 by the BLM. We found and remonumented the closing corner between Sections 7 & 18 and remonumented its original position. The subdivision of Section 7 was computed using the standard subdivision procedure of the 1973 BLM Manual. The closing corners' positions where the section lines intersect the range line were calculated but not monumented. The sixteenth positions on the North and South lines of Section 7 were calculated using the original GLO positions. The parenthetical distances for the lots were computed using the original acreages. The position for the West quarter corner for Section 7 only was calculated but not set.
