



RECORD OF ORIGINAL CORNER:

No record of corner having been previously monumented. The position of this corner is established by the methods and procedures defined in the U.S. Bureau of Land Management, *Manual of Survey Instructions 73*, and as shown herein.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a NOT OF RECORD standard USDA Forest Service 3 1/4 ins. diam. alum. cap on 2 1/2 ins. diam. alum. post, firmly set, in good condition, 5 ins. abv. gnd in rock collar, mkd. as shown:



From which bearing trees NOT OF RECORD:

A ponderosa pine, 12 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears S. 85 1/2° E., 22.2 ft. dist., with healed blaze. Opening healed blaze reveals scribe mks. S1/16 S31 BT.

A ponderosa pine, 14 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears S. 45 1/2° W., 20.4 ft. dist., with healed blaze.

A sugar pine, 12 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears S. 85 1/2° E., 22.2 ft. dist., with healed blaze. Opening healed blaze reveals scribe mks. S1/16 S31 BT.

A sugar pine, 12 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears S. 85 1/2° E., 22.2 ft. dist., with healed blaze. Opening healed blaze reveals scribe mks. S1/16 S31 BT.

This survey finds the monument within 0.3 ft. of the proper proportionate position of the S1/16 cor. of secs. 31 and 36 and accepts the monumented position as the S1/16 cor.

RECORD OF ORIGINAL CORNER:

Original corner set by A.A. Smith, under GLO Contract dated September 18, 1876, approved January 18, 1878. Record states:

Set a fir post 48 x 3 x 3 in a stone mound for 1/4 section corner. From which:

Yellow pine 18 ins. diameter bears N. 88° E., 70 lks. dist. Spruce 44 ins. diameter bears West 52 lks. dist.

Subsequent Monumentation:

This corner was remonumented by Adam Sydlik, cadastral surveyor, under Group No. 540, approved May 16, 1977. Record states: The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, monumented by an old embedded mound of stone, 3 ft. diam., 6 ins. high.

From which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A yellow pine, 26 ins. diam., bears East, 70 lks. dist., with overgrown blaze. (Record: N. 88° E.) A sawed fir stump, 50 ins. diam., bears West, 52 lks. dist. (Record: Specie: Spruce)

Set and iron post 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. From which:

Found a standard BLM 3 1/4 ins. diam. brass cap on 2 1/2 ins. diam. iron post, firmly set in good condition, 6 ins. abv. gnd in rock collar, mkd. as shown abv. From which the remains of an original bearing tree:

A rotted fir snag, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 83°, 64 lks. dist., with old chopped rotted blaze. (1878 Record: S. 61° E.) and the bearing trees mkd. by Sydlik

A stump hole, bears at record (S. 59° E., 53 lks. dist.).

A sugar pine, 36 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears at record (N. 61° W., 15 lks. dist.), with healed blaze. and mkd. bearing trees NOT OF RECORD

A fir, 11 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears N. 84° E., 9.3 ft. dist., with healed blaze.

A cedar, 18 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears S. 53° E., 8.7 ft. dist., with open blaze and scribe mks.

Original corner set by A.A. Smith, under GLO Contract dated September 18, 1876, approved January 18, 1878.

Record states:

Set a fir post 48 x 4 x 4 in. a stone mound for corner to sections 25, 30, 31 and 36.

From which:

Fir 10 in. dia. N. 22 1/2° W. 31 lks. distant.

Fir 8 ins. diameter S. 61° E. 64 lks. distant.

Fir 16 ins. diameter S. 43° W. 116 lks. distant.

Fir 22 ins. diameter N. 32 1/2° E. 174 lks. dist.

Subsequent Monumentation:

This corner was remonumented by Adam Sydlik, cadastral surveyor, under Group No. 540, approved May 16, 1977. Record states: The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, monumented by an old embedded mound of stone, 2 1/2 ft. diam., 4 ins. high.

From which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A rotted fir snag, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 83° E., 64 lks. dist., with old chopped rotted blaze. (Record: S. 61° E.)

A sawed fir stump, bears N. 26° W., 23 lks. dist., with log lying downhill, with scribe marks BT visible on old open blaze. (Record: N. 22 1/2° W., 31 lks. dist.)

At the corner point:

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



A white fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 25° W. 14 lks. dist., mkd. T28N R11E S36 BT.

A sugar pine, 23 ins. diam., bears N. 61° W. 15 lks. dist., mkd. T28N R11E S25 BT.

Rebuild the mound of stone, 3 ft. base, around post to top.

Found a standard BLM 3 1/4 ins. diam. brass cap on 2 1/2 ins. diam. iron post, firmly set in good condition, 6 ins. abv. gnd in rock collar, mkd. as shown abv. From which the remains of an original bearing tree:

A rotted fir snag, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 83°, 64 lks. dist., with old chopped rotted blaze. (1878 Record: S. 61° E.) and the bearing trees mkd. by Sydlik

A stump hole, bears at record (S. 59° E., 53 lks. dist.).

A sugar pine, 36 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears at record (N. 61° W., 15 lks. dist.), with healed blaze. and mkd. bearing trees NOT OF RECORD

A fir, 11 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears N. 84° E., 9.3 ft. dist., with healed blaze.

A cedar, 18 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears S. 53° E., 8.7 ft. dist., with open blaze and scribe mks.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears N. 20° W. 61 lks. dist., with healed blaze. (1878 Record: N. 43° W. 27 lks. dist.)

and the bearing trees mkd. by Sydlik

A stump hole, with nearby down tree remains with Attention sign, bears N. 41° E., 51 lks. dist.

A dead and standing fir, 33 ins. diam., bears S. 16° E., 118 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

and mkd. bearing tree NOT OF RECORD

A pine, 12 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears S. 51° W., 10.7 ft. dist., with healed blaze.

The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 30, monumented by the original cor. tree, a pine, 24 ins. diam., with overgrown blaze on E. face,

An uprooted fir snag, bears N. 33° E., 44 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT visible on partially open blaze. (Record:

N. 81° E., 42 lks. dist.)

An iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground for a reference monument, bears N. 45° E., 9 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. RM 6 ft. to 1/4 COR 1968, and an arrow pointing to the corner. Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, around post to top.

Found the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 30, monumented by the original cor. tree, a pine, 32 ins. diam., alive and healthy, with healed blaze on E. face. From which the remains of an original bearing tree:

The remains of a down fir tree, bears N. 73° E., 44 lks. dist., (1878 Record: N. 81° E., 42 lks. dist.) and the bearing trees mkd. by Sydlik

A fir, 17 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears S. 57° E., 23 1/2 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 26 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears N. 69° W., 33 1/2 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A reference monument, a standard BLM 3 1/4 ins. diam. brass cap on 2 1/2 ins. diam. iron post, firmly set in good condition, 4 ins. abv. gnd in rock collar, bears N. 45° E., 9 lks. dist., mkd. RM 6 ft. to 1/4 COR 1968, and an arrow pointing to the corner.</
