Basis of Bearings

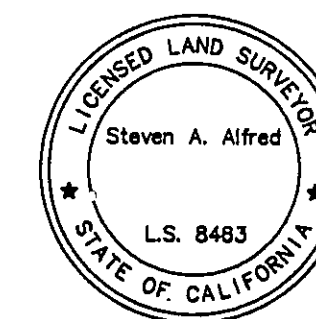

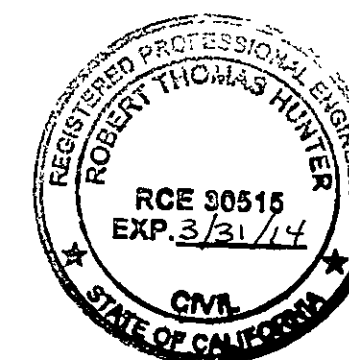
