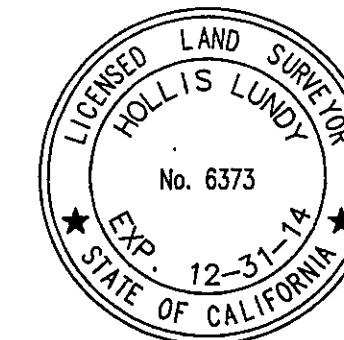

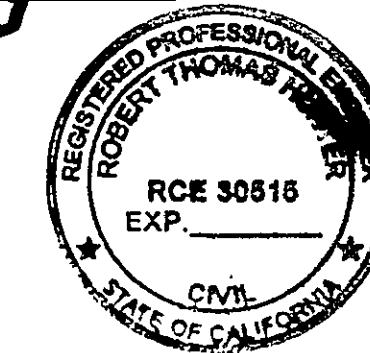

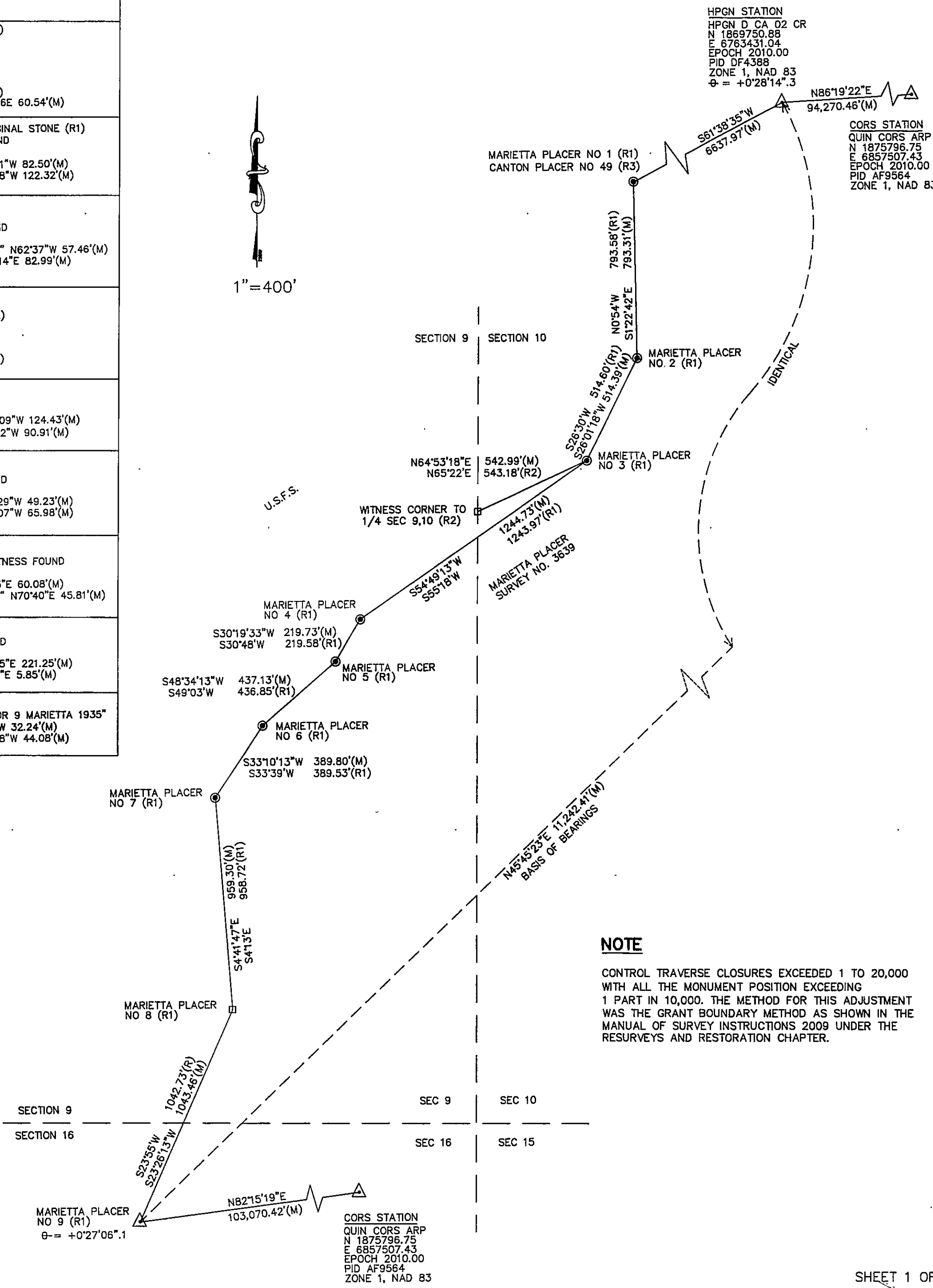

### BASIS OF BEARINGS

THE BASIS OF BEARINGS FOR THIS SURVEY IS THE CALIFORNIA STATE PLANE GRID COORDINATE SYSTEM, ZONE 1, NAD 83, EPOCH 2010.00, AS ESTABLISHED BY G.P.S.. THE DISTANCES SHOWN AS (M) ARE GRID DISTANCES. TO CALCULATE SURFACE MEASUREMENTS, MULTIPLY BY THE COMBINATION FACTOR OF 1.000080935

### NOTE

CONTROL TRAVERSE CLOSURES EXCEEDED 1 TO 20,000 WITH ALL THE MONUMENT POSITION EXCEEDING 1 PART IN 10,000. THE METHOD FOR THIS ADJUSTMENT WAS THE GRANT BOUNDARY METHOD AS SHOWN IN THE MANUAL OF SURVEY INSTRUCTIONS 2009 UNDER THE RESURVEYS AND RESTORATION CHAPTER.
